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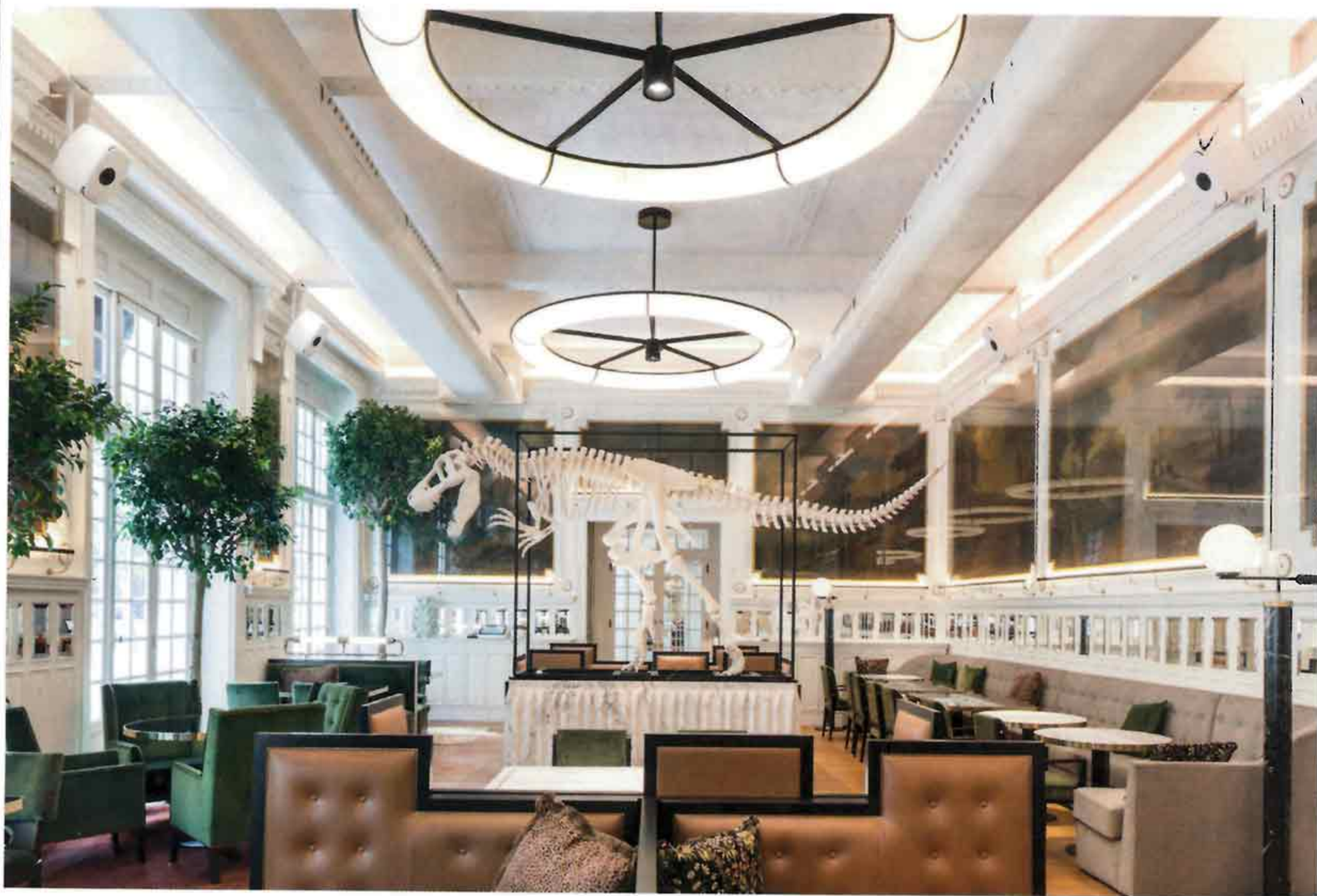

Floor show

JNÊQUOI, LISBON

Housed in the former Teatro Tivoli, a 1920s building on Lisbon's grand Avenida da Liberdade, JNÊQUOI – or Je Ne Sais Quoi – is the latest venture from Amorim Luxury, owner of the Fashion Clinic stores. This humming emporium, set over three floors, has been dressed by Barcelona-based designer Lázaro Rosa-Violán with muted furnishings in low-level hues that accent the detailed cornicing and elaborate frescoes that have carefully been brought back to life. At entry level, Ladurée and Assouline retail outlets flank the central grocery store and DeliBar, which serves up a menu of light meals including oysters and caviar, while downstairs is a menswear haven showcasing brands ranging from Tom Ford to Christian Louboutin. However, the emporium's real highlight is the top-floor restaurant, where dishes such as sea bass ceviche or melt-in-the-mouth Iberian pork loin are served in a light-filled room featuring, for reasons not entirely clear, a replica dinosaur skeleton. **Mary Lussiana**
