THE DESIGNER CHOSE THE ART PIECES AND EVEN TOOK SOME OF THE PHOTOS HANGING ON THE WALL. Characterized by its great location just minutes from Plaza Catalunya, the Ramblas, and Paseo de Gracis-Hotel Pulitzer is turning heads for its stylish design features and charming ambiance. Interior designer Lázaro Rosa Violán's goal was to set about creating a hotel that felt more like a palace than a hotel-no small task in a city known for its design savvy. Radiating cosmopolitan cool, the hotel lobby evokes grandeur and beauty with its Sicilian altar-cum-reception desk. Every public area is flooded with natural light, which heightens the sense of spaciousness.

Outfitted with a terrace/solarium, Suite 516 is gracious in size and beautifully appointed. Violán favored inky blacks, pearly whites, and charcoal grays, but the sober color scheme gets a jolt of glitz with gold highlights, white leather, and caramel-toned wood detailing. Leather chairs flank the fireplace, lending

> a masculine touch to the room that contrasts with the canopied bed, which seemingly floats in the room (pages 248 to 249).

Even the bathroom is regal in size and pleasantly somber in its color palette (page 252). Art pieces like a Grecianinspired sculpture and a framed purpleand-white kimono span the globe, from Europe to the Far East, and lend an exotic atmosphere to the otherwise subtle design Even the room's photos were chosen-and in some cases taken-by Violán, giving guests the feeling of staying in the questroom at the designer's home.

The hotel is situated within walking distance to some of Barcelona's most popular tourist sites, like the Gothic Quarter, the Picasso museum, and Gaudi's house for the Battló family. A tourist destination in its own right, Hotel Pulitzer has enough panache to charm the most cynical of critics.
